Description

The project was realized as a three-day event. The project consisted of activities that were consistent with the goals of the project and were set up according to themes. The activities were set up in such a way that they fit perfectly with the idea of the project and targeted all priorities. Their goal was to appeal to everyone and make a deep impression on the

participants. The set of events was intended for all age groups, mainly targeting the young productive generation and disadvantaged children.

Thursday - 03.08.2023 - Welcome

The first day was focused on the ceremonial reception of the partners. The delegation was received with hospitality in accordance with local traditions and local specialties and traditional dishes awaited the guests, which were accompanied by a rich cultural program of folk traditions. Afterwards, the partners introduced themselves and presented their own traditional cultural values and folklore. On the first day, the program cavalcade was presented, where important keywords of the project were discussed, such as tolerance, solidarity, Euroscepticism, togetherness, gender inequality, discrimination and racism. We gained an overview of the culture of each country, their traditions, industrial arts, and folk customs. We point to the cooperation and tolerance of different cultures within the European Union.

Friday - 04/08/2023 - Working together for a better future

Its dedicated professional community (teachers, professors, politicians) provided relevant information in lectures, seminars, and free discussions about the importance of the European Parliament elections, persistent gender inequality, and various manifestations of discrimination, with particular regard to the Roma minority. With the help of a professional representative, we explained the mechanism of the European Parliament elections, the role of representatives in our countries, and the European Parliament after the 2024 elections. We referred to the need to involve young people in the construction of the future EU. We explained the operation of the "Future of Europe Conference" specifically for young people, and at the same time we wanted to motivate them to participate more actively in the formation of self-government.

Saturday - 05.08.2023 - See you again

The third day of the event, which was also the last day, will be organized in this spirit. Mayor Újrónafő showed the sights of the area. Special attention was given to the description of the Cinka Panna Tanoda program and its on-site presentation, where the partners could observe where and how the employment of disadvantaged children takes place. After that, as the last program of the program cavalcade, the closing meeting of the partners took place, where they evaluated the project itself, its positives and negatives, and took measures to improve cooperation, which will have an impact even after the project has been implemented.

Many volunteers helped to ensure that the programs were carried out according to their goals and priorities. Care was taken to avoid any conflict, racist or other unethical expressions and above all to have fun. During the implementation of the programs, we put a lot of emphasis on the selective collection of the generated waste, we tried to create as little waste as possible, so we used reusable glasses during the event.

The partners agreed that they would like to continue their friendly partnership in the future, which enriches each partner with many friendly, business and practical experiences. The programs had a positive impact on all participants and increased their general knowledge of the EU, its functioning and social problems such as racism and gender inequality and how to overcome them.
